ENTRY FORM AND RULES ON BACK

TOURNAMENT RULES (Failure to read is no excuse)

- 1. All participants must have bowled in a TNBA & USBC Youth Division certified league for the 2018 2019 season.
- 2. No USBC Youth Division certification cards may be purchased at the tournament site. TNBA certification cards may be purchased for \$10.00 fee. All bowlers must show proof of certification in TNBA &USBC Youth Division before bowling.
- 3. All participants must use their highest **TNBA/USBC** certified average, with a minimum of 21 games, as of April 20, 2019. Certified **USBC High School** averages may be used.
- 4. All participants must submit a league standing sheet along with their entry.
- 5. Classic bowlers (169 & under for boys & girls) will have the option to choose either the Masters or Classic division to participate in. Once chosen, the decision is final.
- 6. ENTRY CLOSING DATE: All RESERVED entries must be fully paid and received by June 7th, 2019. All entries received after June 7th will be assessed a \$15.00 late fee. No mail in entries will be accepted after June 1st, 2019
- 7. Tournament format all divisions:
 - a) All entrants will bowl two (2), four (4) game blocks on Saturday June 8th, Squad starting @ 9:30am
 - b) Field will be cut by 50%, based on highest total pin fall for eight (8) games These bowlers will return on Sunday June 9th @ 9:30am to bowl a four (4) game block
 - c) The top eight (8) bowlers will be determined by the highest total pin fall for the twelve (12) games. These bowlers will bowl an eight man bracket elimination with bowlers bowling two (2) game matches. Winners advancing.
 - d) The final match between the top two (2) finalists for the championship will be bowled on a neutral pair of lanes
- 8. In case of a tie for any position, there will be a ninth (9th) and tenth (10th) frame roll-off until tie is broken. All other ties will result in split awards.
- 9. ALTERNATE BOWLER: When an alternate bowler enters the tournament, the bowler being replaced cannot return in this tournament. The alternate assumes the score of the bowler he/she is replacing, minus one hundred (100) pins.
- 10. All participants are requested to wear shirts/blouses with collars with their names on the back. Short-shorts, cut-offs, baggy jeans, baggy pants or headgear WILL NOT be allowed. BOWLERS MUST BE PROPERLY ATTIRED.
- 11. Registration and check-in will be Friday June 7th at 7pm and Saturday June 8th, at 8:00am. Registration will close at 8:30am
- 12. on Saturday June 8th. A **MAXIMUM** of five (5) balls may be checked in.
- 13. Award fund will be paid 100%. Award ratio will be at least one (1) award for every eight (8) entries. *All awards are in the form of Scholarships*. Bracket awards are in the form of scholarships.
- 14. SMART Program will distribute all awards.
- 15. Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, natural disasters, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or there from; fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, or other reasons beyond the control of the TNBA Junior Singles Scratch Tournament, shall cause the forgoing award schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled.
- 16. All rules not stated above will be governed by TNBA & USBC Youth Division rules.
- 17. THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WILL MAKE ALL DECISIONS AND RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE OR REJECT ANY ENTRY.
